RULES & REGULATIONS FOR SUSSEX MINOR HOCKEY - 50/50 ICE CASH LOTTERY #1524529 56 000

- 1. The Sussex Minor Hockey 50/50 Ice Cash Lottery tickets will be sold at businesses in the Sussex and surrounding area. The selected stores will be registered by the committee and they will have to fill out a form stating that they are allowing the 50/50 Ice Cash Lottery to be sold at their store and are gaining no profit from Sussex Minor Hockey.
- 2. Each store will have tickets, stickers, pen and sealed box. The ticket purchaser will select a registration card and fill out the designated part of the ticket with name, number and address. They will keep the perforated side of the stub that holds the number for their own reference. Place the filled out part of the ticket in the ice cash box. The ticket holder will then take a sticker and write their number only on the sticker. The sticker will then be stuck to the toonie and placed in the sealed box. The purchaser will then need to make sure their number is paid in full each week to be placed in the weekly draw. **There is no age restriction to play Ice Cash**
- 3. The Sussex Minor Hockey 50/50 Ice Cash Lottery Committee will have a spreadsheet to keep all registered ticket holders information and number, and will be updated weekly.
- 4. The Sussex Minor Hockey 50/50 Ice Cash Lottery Committee members will pick up the tickets and money from each of the designated stores on Thursday by 4:00 pm Atlantic time (being the cut off time).
- 5. Persons on the Sussex Minor Hockey Ice Cash Lottery Committee will draw a random number from a bucket that is between the designated numbers used. The number drawn will be posted in registered stores and on Kings County Hockey Connection Facebook page.
- 6. If the number that was drawn was not paid in full for that week; the amount that was to be won will be carried over to the following week, a new number will not be drawn that week
- 7. At year end it will be done differently, another number will be drawn until a paid number is drawn. This is to complete the Sussex Minor Hockey 50/50 Ice Cash Lottery draw for the year. The Sussex Minor Hockey Ice Cash Lottery will have a weekly 50/50 draw.
- 8. Once toonies are placed in the ice cash boxes, they become property of Sussex Minor Hockey. Players need to take due care to ensure they are playing in the correct box and also that they are playing their correct ice cash #.
- 9. Due to the large number of toonies being collected and counted each week, we are not able to accommodate players who have made any errors in writing their numbers.
